When we suddenly sold our own Greek house and we learnt Wendy and Nigel's beautiful Greek cottage was available we were overjoyed. The quiet location, stunning sea and village views helped to mitigate the loss of our own hideaway in a way we had not thought possible. The two sea-facing terraces, accessed from the main rooms, the pretty garden with its adventure playground (which we refrained from using!) and the surrounding olive trees provide a really lovely setting. It is possible to walk down to Livadi seashore for a swim, or to relax on the beach, and to a choice of tavernas as well as walk further afield, although a car would be advisable and probably essential, especially to reach the shops and better beaches. It's characterful, attractively furnished huge sitting room with open plan well equipped kitchen dining area runs the full length of the house on the upper floor. On the ground floor two well furnished bedrooms with comfortable beds, generous wardrobes and chests of drawers mean there is plenty of room for all your possessions; a bathroom with toilet and washing machine and a smaller cloakroom with separate w.c and basin mean there are no bathroom queues! The house is so well equipped I think you would be hard pressed not to find everything you need to make your stay comfortable. The first thing to say, after a weekend spent in this house, is that everything the website says about it is true. I was impressed by the quality of the furniture and equipment (sofas, chairs, dining table and chairs, comfortable beds, very nice plates, mugs, bathroom accessories, etc.) – unusual in a rented holiday house. We had not presented a shopping list, but we found small but adequate supplies of salt, pepper, sugar, tea, instant coffee and some other basics. I think the reason why you don't always find these in rented houses in Greece is that the cleaners take them home at the end of each let, but since the owners are looking after the house themselves they won't do that.

You may be a bit taken aback to find that the front door leads straight into the bedroom and bathroom floor, but the design is absolutely right. It means that the living room and good-sized balcony – where you'll be spending your time when you're not asleep – have a great view over the tops of the olive trees.

One good point we think the owners could have made more of is the seclusion. "A quiet hillside" is right. The main road (not a particularly busy one) is only a minute's drive away, but it might almost not be there. All you are aware of are the olive trees round about and the view over the little village and the sea. A car is pretty well essential.

I am no expert on birds but I love hoopoes, and I saw one on each of my days there.

I would certainly recommend this place for a family holiday.
